VA Energy Transition Summit

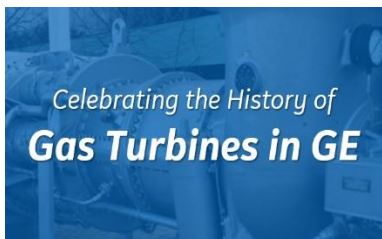
